From that time, she excelled as a Music Director for Youth for Tomorrow, founded by Joe Gibbs, which included presidential performances at the White House and the Kennedy Center, performed the role of worship leader for various Christian ministries, including International Women in Leadership Conference in Bulgaria, and a premier performance for Trinity Broadcasting Network for the International Call to Prayer. Her ultimate call is to help redeem the lives and talents of artists into God's kingdom.
